1. General

1.a. About the Congress

The Asia-Pacific Federation for Clinical Biochemistry ("APFCB") is a federation of 16 national and area associations of clinical biochemistry and laboratory medicine in the Asia-Pacific region whose membership comprises the following:

- Australasian Association of Clinical Biochemists (AACB)
- Chinese Society of Laboratory Medicine (CSLM)
- Hong Kong Society of Clinical Chemistry (HKSCC)
- Association of Clinical Biochemists of India (ACBI)
- Indonesian Association for Clinical Chemistry (IACC)
- Japan Society of Clinical Chemistry (JSCC)
- Korean Society of Clinical Chemistry (KSCC)
- Malaysian Association of Clinical Biochemists (MACB)
- Nepal Association for Medical Laboratory Sciences (NAMLS)
- Pakistan Society of Chemical Pathologists (PSCP)
- Philippine Association of Medical Technologists (PAMET)
- Singapore Association of Clinical Biochemists (SACB)
- Association for Clinical Biochemistry, Sri Lanka (ACBSL)
- Chinese Association for Clinical Biochemistry, Taiwan (CACB)
- Thailand Association of Clinical Biochemists (TACB)
- Vietnamese Association of Clinical Biochemistry (VACB)

The APFCB is domiciled in Singapore where its bank account is also maintained. The APFCB Office in Singapore manages the APFCB's financial and regulatory affairs. The professional activities of the APFCB are executed through its five standing committees, these being the Communications (C-Comm), Education (C-Edu), Laboratory Management (C-LM), Scientific (C-Sci) and Congress and Conferences (C-CC) committees.

The C-CC is involved in the planning and supervising of the triennial APFCB congress and APFCB regional conferences and works closely with the local organizing committees to ensure the success of these congresses. The triennial Asian-Pacific Congress of Clinical Biochemistry (APCCBs), now renamed APFCB congress, is the scientific congress of the APFCB. The first congress was held in 1979 in Singapore. The 13th APFCB congress was held in Bali, Indonesia in 2013.

1.b. Conference Cooperation Agreement

Based on agreement No. 005/CVX-IACC/IKS/II/2012 dated January 25, 2012, PT Pacto Convex Niagatama ("Pacto") and Indonesian Association for Clinical Chemistry ("IACC") entered into Conference Cooperation Agreement.

Pacto is limited liability company established and exists pursuant to and according to the legal provisions prevailing in Indonesia, and has obtained the license to run its business activities from a competent government institution, and is a capable/reputable company, especially as an event organizer.

IACC, an association of clinical chemistry business in Indonesia, formed in 1979 through the endorsement of the APFCB, is hosting "The 13th Asia-Pacific Federation for Clinical Biochemistry Congress" ("APFCB 2013 Congress") at Bali Nusa Dua Convention Centre.

IACC has appointed Pacto to organize and manage the preparation and implementation of APFCB 2013 Congress and carry out its best effort to attract participation of sponsors and participants.

Pacto in organizing and managing the preparation and implementation of APFCB 2013 Congress provided and delivered its services to cover all aspects of pre, during and post-event service that is required and expected for the successful delivery of a professional conference.

1.c. Organizing Committee

The organizing committee of APFCB 2013 Congress was held in Bali, Indonesia on October 27 - 30, 2013, is as follows:

Other organizing committees consist of Scientific, Scientific Meeting Facility, Exhibition, Social Programme, Accommodation & Transportation, Publication & Promotion, and International Advisory Board.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

2.a. Basis of Statement of Cash Receipts and Disbursements Preparation

The statements of cash receipts and disbursements are prepared using the cash basis of accounting, which is an other comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles applied in Indonesia. The statements present all receipt and disbursement related to APFCB 2013 Congress.

APFCB 2013 Congress' general books of accounts are maintained in Indonesian Rupiah (IDR) and United States Dollar (USD). All transactions in IDR are recorded and reported in IDR; and all transactions in USD are recorded and reported in USD.

2.b. Cash Surplus / Deficit

Source of funds to finance APFCB 2013 Congress are receipts from registration fee from participants, rental fee from exhibition participants, sponsorships, and other legal sources; net off refund. All expenditures consist of fixed cost and variable costs. A surplus or positive net cash received from receipts deducted by actual expenditures will share equally, 50% for IACC and 50% for Pacto, after all actual expenditures have been calculated and fully paid.

For the purpose of this report, cash surplus / deficit is calculated up to February 28, 2014. Balance of cash surplus / deficit as of December 31, 2013, will be added and deducted with the transactions during January 1, 2014 up to February 28, 2014. Receivable from registration fee and sponsorship as of February 28, 2014, will be added to the balance of cash surplus / deficit. Balance of cash surplus as of February 28, 2014 denominated in USD is converted into IDR using the rate of exchange prevailing issued by the Bank of Indonesia is USD 1 = IDR 11,634.

2.c. Refund

Refund can be done with the following conditions, such as:

- (a) The paper/abstract is not approved or accepted.
- (b) Excess payment due to an error in the payment system which should be special price but subject to charge normal price.
