

**The APFCB Young Scientists Award for the ICBMBLM 2025
in conjunction with 35 MACB & 49 MSBMB ANNUAL CONFERENCE**

Objective:

The APFCB Young Scientist Award is a financial support of young scientist to attend international scientific conference, which is conducted by the APFCB through its Education Committee with the following objectives:

1. Foster scientific potential of young scientists within the Asia-Pacific region,
2. As a means of aiding and encouraging young scientists in written and oral communication of their research results

Eligibility:

1. Scientists under the age of 40 on 25 August 2025, opening of the INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BIOCHEMISTRY, MOLECULAR BIOLOGY & LABORATORY MEDICINE (ICBMBLM) 2025 in conjunction with the 35th MALAYSIAN ASSOCIATION OF CLINICAL BIOCHEMISTS (MACB) & 49th MALAYSIAN SOCIETY FOR BIOCHEMISTRY AND MOLECULAR BIOLOGY (MSBMB) ANNUAL CONFERENCE in Petaling Jaya, Malaysia.
2. Scientists whose abstract have been accepted by this Conference but they have no any other financial support awarded for this congress.
3. Researcher must reside in the Asia Pacific region (all Asian countries except Arab region), Australasia, or Pacific islands, and must be a member of local APFCB member societies.

Requirements:

The selection process will take place starting July 14, 2025 with the following conditions:

1. Submission of an abstract accepted by the Conference is required and assessed by APFCB Education Committee.
2. The applicant should be the single author of the submitted abstract, or the first author or correspondence author in a group research project.
3. The copy of the first page of applicant's passport is required as a proof of age.
4. A supporting letter by the applicant's supervisor should be provided, which should confirm the membership of applicant in the local APFCB member society.
5. Each applicant may submit ONLY one abstract if they have several abstracts accepted by the Conference.
6. All the submissions must include a title page with the following information: title of the paper, name of scientist, affiliation name and address, researcher's email address and name, address and email address of the sponsor who endorses the project.
7. Deadline of submission is July 13, 2025
8. The APFCB Education Committee will be in charge for determining the winners of this competition. All submissions shall be addressed to: Prof Wei Cui, Chair of APFCB Education Committee, email address: wendycuiwei@hotmail.com

Successful candidates:

1. There will be two winners selected from all submitted papers.
2. These two successful winner will be invited to the ICBMBLM 2025 in conjunction with 35 MACB & 49 MSBMB ANNUAL CONFERENCE in Petaling Jaya, Malaysia, from August 25-27, 2025. Expenses of each winner will be covered by this award to a limit of SGD 2,000, including flight & local taxi, four-night accommodation and pre-conference workshop and conference registration fee. The flight specifically refers to economy class flight and the hotel charge is limited to 120 SGD per night.

The APFCB encourages scientists under the age of 40 to participate in the competition for the award, through which you will have unique opportunities to learn a crucial part of scientific work which is communicating your work to others.
